Several years ago, Dial Hope recognized a need to more effectively provide outreach to the Spanish speaking community. The goal was to address not only the community in the United States, but abroad. Spanish is the second most prevalent language to English in the United States and with approximatley 580 million people worldwide speaking Spanish as their native language, it was a significant priority to our organization. In 2015, Noel Salmeron agreed to assist Dial Hope's Ministry with the translation of daily messages in order to target the Spanish speaking community in the United States and abroad. To launch this phase, Dial Hope built the capacity for this new endeavor and was able to publish the first message, in Spanish, on July 1st, 2016. Since then, Salmeron has traslated 2,069 messages, providing a word of

encouragement for everyone that needs God in their life. Salmeron became a board member of Dial Hope on May 10th, 2021, and from his country, Nicaragua, he is committed to Dial Hope's ministry and its outreach to the Spanish speaking community.


